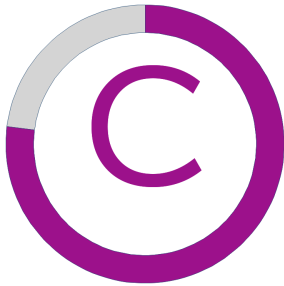

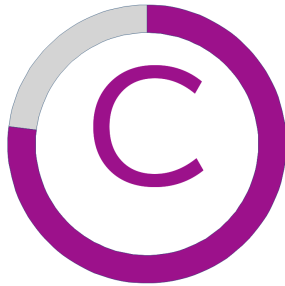

### Overall Rating



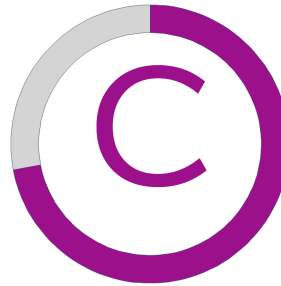

### Student Achievement



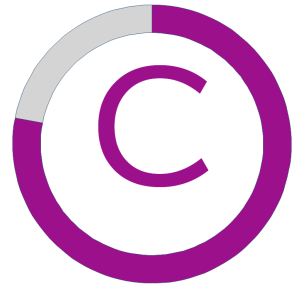

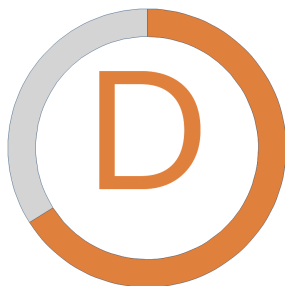

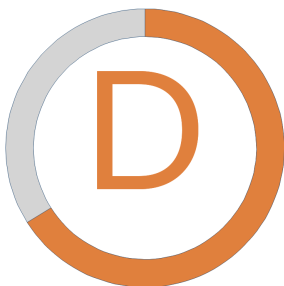

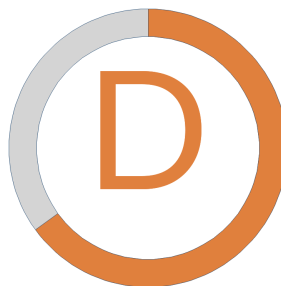

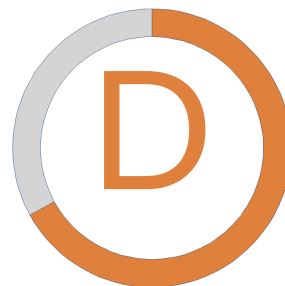

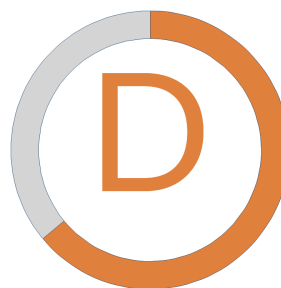

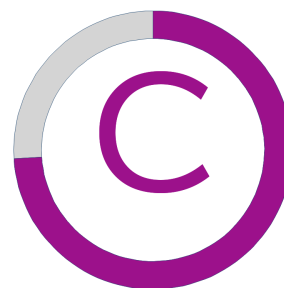

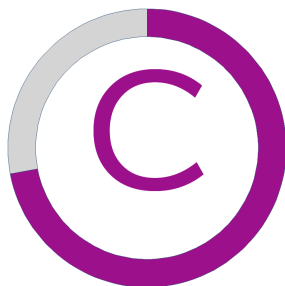

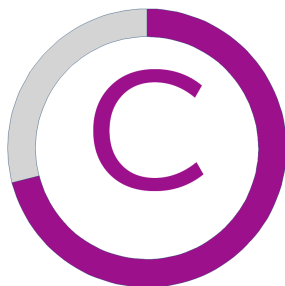

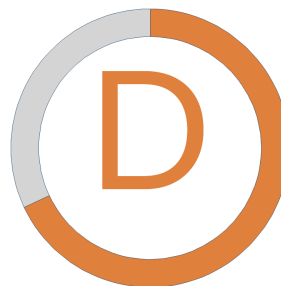

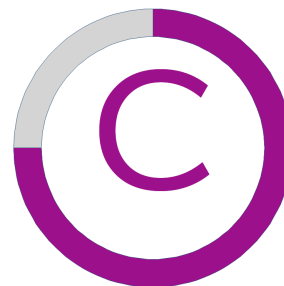
